

## **Minutes of Redgrave Neighbourhood Plan Working Group Meeting**

Held on Monday 10 December 2018 at 2 Rectory Green, Redgrave

A question was raised over whether a Neighbourhood Plan or the forming of a Community Land Trust would be more appropriate for Redgrave. Janet will ask Elizabeth Ling from Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Council (expert on Community Land Trusts) to come to the next meeting to talk through the options in detail.

It was suggested that we wait for the Mid Suffolk Plan to be published (due imminently) before making any decisions but it was felt we could work in parallel and start the process.

Costs, grants, consultants and the Botesdale and Rickinghall Plan were discussed.

John has sent off the initial NP form to Mid Suffolk to start the ball rolling.

It was decided that we need to:

Look into Community Land Trusts

Look at the Neighbourhood Plans of similar sized hinterland villages.

Work out the scope of the Plan.

**Charley** will look at Neighbourhood Plans of similar villages in Mid Suffolk and Babergh

**Jon** will look at Plans of similar villages in Breckland and South Norfolk

**Shirley** will look at Plans of similar villages in Herefordshire.

**John** will investigate the Community Land Trust set up in Lavenham.

**Janet** will contact Elizabeth Ling re Community Land Trusts

**All** to look at the Locality website

**Jon** has agreed to create a website then hand the administration of this over to **Chris**.

**Jon** will also set up a One Drive account to replace Dropbox then hand it over to **Chris** to administer.
