1.	All were welcomed to the meeting.	
2.	The Minutes of the meeting held on 5 September were accepted.	
3.	<p>It was agreed that questionnaire results and comments should be posted to the RNP website. The link to the website will be published in the Parish Magazine along with the dates for the public exhibitions. The exhibition will be at All Saints on Saturday 30 November from 10-1 with bacon butties, tea and coffee and in the Cross Keys on Tuesday 3 December from 6-8 when the bar will be open and Shirley's famous sausage rolls will be available. It was decided that we should cater for 30 at each venue (first come, first served for food). To be advertised as Redgrave Neighbourhood Plan Public Exhibition 'See our first ideas for policies – have your say'. We will have a series of boards about the vision, the objectives and the policies. People will be asked for their views and given the chance to give their opinions and choices using coloured dots and post-it notes. There will also be boards about community action projects and how we are addressing these. Andrea will be available to answer any awkward questions. We will need to take as many photos as possible. There will be a sheet to be filled in as people enter the exhibition to establish demographics and to find out how the villagers found out about the exhibition – and any other useful information. Shirley volunteered to put posters up advertising the exhibition around the village. Janet will send an email to the larger group (using the list from OneDrive) asking for help with all aspects including the kitchen and handing out dots and other information. It was agreed that the Vision should be:  Our vision for Redgrave is that by 2036 Redgrave will have continued to be a small beautiful village that has developed sustainably. It will develop in proportion to its rural character; rich in green spaces surrounded by a diverse rural environment with a better balance of housing that meets the needs of its villagers. John and Chris volunteered to visit Gressingham Foods to find out what they would like from the village and how they can contribute to the project. Shirley and Janet will visit the businesses at the Starwings site. Jon will make contact with any small businesses and home workers to get their views.  Shirley will contact Suffolk Wildlife Trust to tell them about the proposed events and to find out their environment policies and discuss the development of access.
